Procedures for Directors and Students

- 1. Directors are encouraged to attend, but not required. It is required that students have some sort of supervision on site with them such as a parent or guardian.
- 2. Students should bring a copy of their music for the judges. If they forget copies, they can tell the registration desk and the ASTA personnel will attempt to make a copy for the student. However, copies on site can not be guaranteed.
- 3. At the Registration Table, the students will check in and pay the registration fee. The fee is \$10 per student. Any ensemble over 6 participants will have a capped fee of \$60.
- 4. Registration Fees can be made by cash or check made payable to TN ASTA.
- 5. After paying the Registration Fee, students will be given their judges sheet and an move on to the warm up room.
- 6. After the student has warmed up, the student can choose from one of 4 different judges to hear them. The students should simply wait outside the judge's room for their turn.
- 7. Piano accompaniment is not required for solos. However, if a student is planning on performing with piano accompaniment, that must be communicated to the event coordinator in advance by email.
- 8. Once the student has played for the judges, the student may return to the warm up room. Approximately 20 minutes after playing for the judges, the student can check back with the registration table for their results. Judges comment sheets and medals will be given to the individual performers at the registration table. A copy of the results will be sent to the associated director on file by email, the following week.
